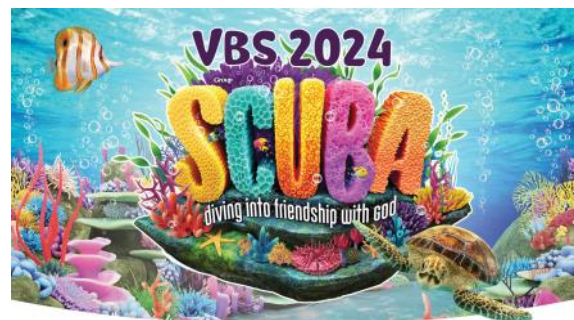
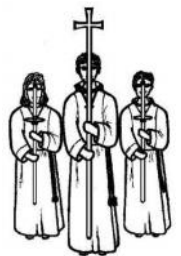
evening. The seamless organization and delicious food truly made the event memorable for all attendees.

Are you looking for a meaningful way to serve your parish community? We are excited to invite new members to join our Altar Server Ministry.

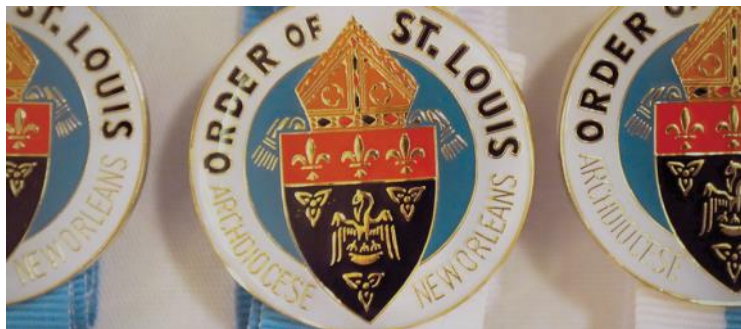
