There's a "Deanery Meeting" at Holy Family next Wed 11/20. What's a <u>deanery</u>?

A deanery is a subdivision of a diocese (or archdiocese), consisting of several parishes, over which presides a dean appointed by the bishop. The duty of the dean is to watch over the clergy of the deanery, to see that they fulfill the orders of the bishop and observe the liturgical and canon laws. He summons periodic meetings of the priests and deacons of his deanery and presides at them. Annually, semi-annually, or as needed, he reports to the bishop on concerns and conditions in the deanery. Holy Family belongs to the West St Tammany-Washington Deanery of the Archdiocese of New Orleans, along with St John the Baptist (Folsom), St Jane de Chantal (Abita Springs), St Peter, St Benedict, and Most Holy Trinity (Covington), St Anselm (Madisonville), Mary, Queen of Peace and Our Lady of the Lake (Mandeville). Fr Charles Benoit, OSB, pastor of St Benedict, currently serves as dean. Our deanery meets monthly, with each parish hosting by turns. On November 20, it's Holy Family's turn to host the deanery meeting, after which our Altar & Rosary Society will treat the clergy to a home-cooked, soup-to-nuts, Thanksgiving feast.


Thanksgiving Mass Schedule
