

KINDERGARTEN AND YOUNG FIVES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question

What is the age that my child must be to enter Kindergarten in the fall of 2026?

Is it possible to enroll my child in Kindergarten this year, if he/she turns 5 between September 1 and December 31?

What is the Young Fives program?

How will I know what program is the best for my child?

What is the Gesell Observation?

Who should I call if I still have questions?

Answer

Children who turn 5, on or before September 1, 2026, are eligible for Kindergarten, per the State of Michigan.

Although your child wouldn't be eligible for Kindergarten, we have an incredible Young Fives program best suited to fit his/her needs.

This curriculum provides the 'gift of time' so that teachers can help learners develop the social, motor and academic skills necessary to succeed in Kindergarten. The program is 5 days/week, offering half and full day options.

Through the Gesell Observation an evaluation of cognitive, language, motor and social-emotional responses, level of age appropriate norms can be used as a guide to curricula recommendations.

The Gesell Developmental Observation is a comprehensive assessment that assists educators and parents in understanding characteristics of child behavior in relation to typical growth patterns.
