This schedule is for all junior high and high school students.		

 Students are required to be here for the whole exam time. Please don't pick up your child while the exam is taking place. We want to keep the disruptions to a minimum during the exam time.

- The junior high will not be taking what is considered a "normal" exam. The teacher may have a test, assignment or project for the students. It will not count as 20% of their grade like it does in high school.
- There will be snacks for the students between exams, with the exception of Friday 5-30

Below is the Exam Policy in our handbook:

Exam Policy

End of Semester and End of School Year assessments are required for all courses at Nouvel Catholic Central High School. All students in grades 9, 10 and 11 must take 1st and 2nd semester (final) assessment, regardless of their grade in the class. Seniors who have a cumulative grade of A- or higher for a single semester class, may be exempt from taking the final assessment. The teacher has the right to require all of his/her students to take the exam regardless of the student's grade in the class. Students enrolled in AP classes are encouraged to take the AP Exam in May of each school year. If any student has 9 or more unexcused absences in a class, they are required to take the exam for that class.

Attention Parents of Students: Please ensure that all lockers in the locker room are cleaned out by the end of the school day on Tuesday, May 27th. Any items left behind after this date may be discarded.
