Each of our programs follow a curriculum that covers language, mathematics, science, social studies, religion, handwriting, fine and gross motor skills and music.

# Differentiated Curriculum

Traditional preschool curriculum provides opportunities for play-based instruction, while children work individually, in small groups and as a large group. Children learn through play, and in centers focused on expanding language, increasing fine and large motor skills, acquiring concepts and learning how to cooperate with others.

Montessori provides experiences for children to develop independence, self-esteem, order, concentration, coordination and respect for themselves, others and the environment around them. Materials and activities are available to meet the individual and developmental needs of a multi-age group of children.

## Schedule & Program Options

- Child's age on September 1, 2026 will be used for scheduling.
- Parents can select half or full day options to best suit their child's needs.  
**Half Day: 8:00 - 11:00 a.m. Full Day: 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.**
- Children in the full day programs will have lunch, recess and rest time, as well as additional enrichment activities.



### Traditional Preschool

- Students age 3 attend two days: Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Students age 4 attend three days: Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays



### Multi-Age Preschool

- Students age 3 can choose three or five days
- If selecting three days, you pick which three
- Students age 4 will attend all five days



### Multi-Age Montessori

- Students age 3 can choose three or five days
- If selecting three days, you pick which three
- Students age 4 will attend all five days



### Young Fives

For students who turn 5 years old on or before December 31, 2026. This program provides opportunities for children who need additional time for development and maturity before entering kindergarten and for those who just miss the kindergarten cut-off date. Short, structured lessons are taught from a formal curriculum and hands-on work experiences are provided to best meet the needs of the children. Students are introduced to the unique "specials" classes of art, gym, music, Spanish and STEM. Additionally, students will follow the elementary school start/end dates and wear uniforms. School hours are 8:00 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.
