FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

IN THE DESERT

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God’s presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God’s ways behind. On this First Sunday of Lent, Jesus shows us what to do in these moments: stand firm and trust in God.

MARCH 6, 2022

GOOD ZEAL AND TEMPTATIONS

In the chapter of Luke preceding today's Gospel, Jesus was baptized in the Jordan and began his adult ministry. Immediately afterward he was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tested. While this might seem almost surreal as we imagine the devil taking Jesus from place to place, it is really much more simple and common than that. For many of us, as we strive to live our lives, we deal with many temptations. Sometimes it is a matter of having the zeal and desire, but not the practical experience or knowledge to carry out a goal. Other times, we are afraid to ask for the assistance that we need to carry a project through to completion. Or we might think that we deserve more, or that our results should be happening more quickly. Our egos can be destructive.

KNOWING YOUR TOUCHSTONES

When Jesus found himself tested by the devil, he was given several different scenarios. The devil brought up situations that he knew could specifically test Jesus, but similar situations would test any of us. Physical hunger is a real need, and many of us might yearn for success, or better paying jobs, or power, or the like. The difference is that when Jesus was tempted, he had some strong "touchstones" to hold onto, secure answers to lead him. He went to simple, basic scriptures that he could call upon in his time of need. For many, one of those basics would be Jeremiah, "I know the plans I have in mind for you--plans for peace and not disaster." For another it might be the Beatitudes or the twenty-third Psalm. Whatever it may be, have ready those touchstones, those "go to" prayers or phrases that you can hold onto during the times when you are sorely tested in your life. Let those stones be your firm foundation.

O podemos pensar que nos merecemos más, o que nuestros resultados deberían producirse más rápidamente. Nuestro ego puede ser destructivo.

CONOCIENDO TUS REFERENTES

Cuando Jesús se encontró con la prueba del diablo, se le dieron varios escenarios diferentes. El diablo planteó situaciones que sabía que podían poner a prueba a Jesús, pero situaciones similares nos pondrían a prueba a cualquiera de nosotros. El hambre física es una necesidad real, y muchos de nosotros podemos anhelar el éxito, o un trabajo mejor pagado, o el poder, o cosas similares. La diferencia es que cuando Jesús fue tentado, tenía algunos "referentes" fuertes a las que aferrarse, respuestas seguras para guiarlo. Acudió a pasajes de las Escrituras sencillas y básicas a las que podía recurrir en su momento de necesidad. Para muchos, uno de esos fundamentos sería Jeremías: "Yo sé los planes que tengo para ti: planes de paz y no de desastre". Para otro, podrían ser las Bienaventuranzas o el salmo 23. Sea lo que sea, ten preparadas esos referentes, esas oraciones o frases "imprescindibles" a las que puedas aferrarte en los momentos en que tu vida sea sometida a una dura prueba. Deja que esos referentes sean tu fundamento firme.

LENTEN FASTING AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory for Catholics from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Catholics from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

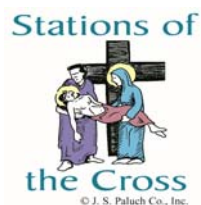
REGLAS CUARESMALES DE AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA



Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. También, los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia.

Para los católicos, las normas son obligatorias desde la edad de 18 años hasta los 59. Cuando se ayuna, se le permite a la persona comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no equivalgan a una comida completa. Las normas sobre la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los católicos desde los 14 años en adelante.

Si es posible, el ayuno del Viernes Santo se continúa hasta la Vigilia Pascual (la noche del Sábado Santo) como el "ayuno pascual" para honrar el sufrimiento y la muerte del Señor Jesús y prepararnos para compartir más plenamente y celebrar más apropiadamente su Resurrección.
