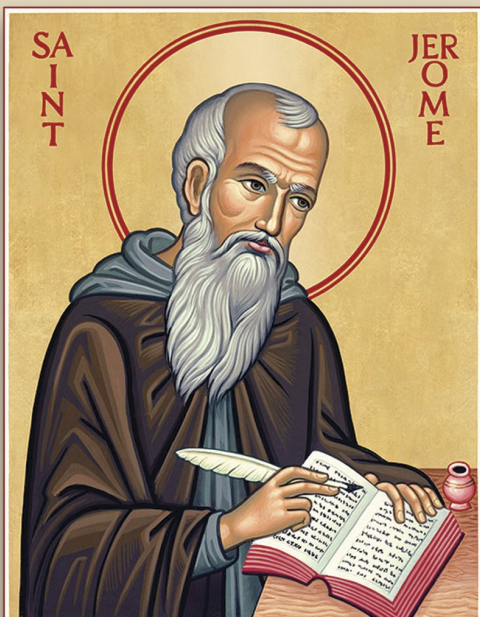

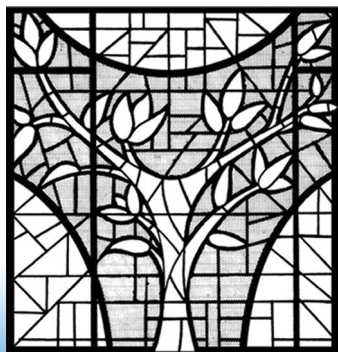

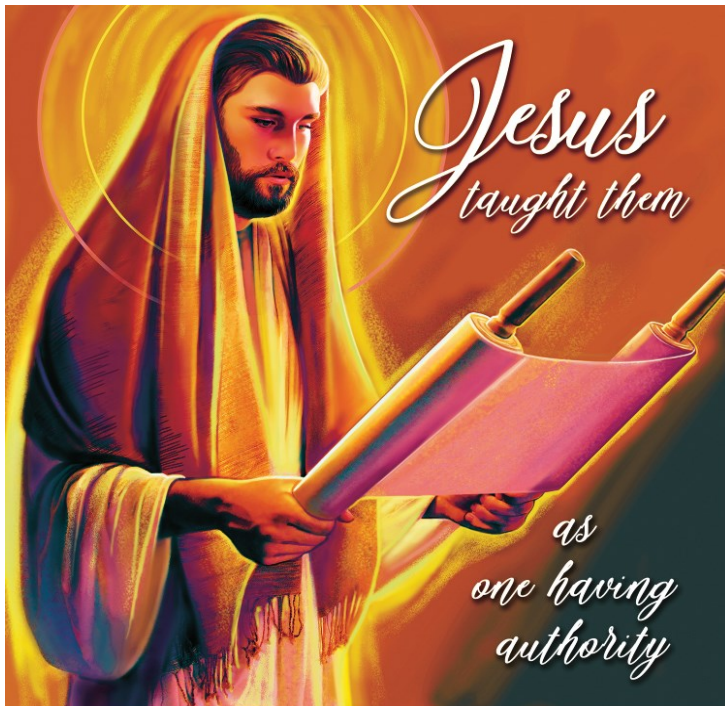

Let us continue to be amazed in today's day and age, just like those who witnessed Christ's miracles firsthand. For His great deeds continue to live on forever. May we always be thankful and eager to respond with similar love for one another.

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El Evangelio de hoy dice: "Los oyentes quedaron asombrados de sus palabras, pues enseñaba como quien tiene autoridad". ¿Qué significa "autoridad"? Ya sea que nos sintamos más impotentes o que tengamos el control total de todo lo que nos rodea, Cristo siempre tiene el poder de tomar el control. A veces permite el sufrimiento.
