# **Sacraments**

**Children in grades 3 and up** should be receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion regularly. As children grow in their relationship with God, they should be attending weekly Mass, be nourished by the Eucharist, and experience the grace of Reconciliation.

**Children in Grade 2** receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation (February) and First Holy Communion (April). This preparation is based on regular attendance in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parents have a special role in this preparation process. Meetings and retreats are held in conjunction with the instruction for each Sacrament. Attendance is expected. Refer to the calendar for dates.

**Children in Grade 9** will receive Confirmation after completing a two-year program. Preparation includes regular class attendance as well as fulfilling other requirements. Candidates need to demonstrate their desire to receive this Sacrament. Reception of Confirmation is a turning point in a young person's life-long faith journey.
