

Please, enjoy the following column from our guest writer, *Father Maximillian Nightingale*. This is part of an ongoing study he is doing of the Psalms and how they are fulfilled in Christ.



on behalf of the life of all humanity, and could truly say "Preserve my life, for **I am holy**."

The last two verses of the Psalm are especially fulfilled in Christ. Psalm 86:16 says, "O give

your strength to servant, save the your hand- Though gave strength to



your and son of maid." God many of the prophets and saints throughout history, it is Christ alone who possesses entirely the **power of God**, being God himself made flesh, and manifesting this power through his resurrection from the dead. "Father, the hour has come; glorify thy Son that the Son may glorify thee, since **you have given him power over all flesh**, to give eternal life to all whom thou hast given him" (John 17:1-2). So also, Christ is truly called "the **son of your handmaid**". This handmaid

of the Lord is none other than Mary, who declares this in her response to the angel, when she says "**I am the handmaid of the Lord**, be it done unto me according to your word" (Luke 1:38). Finally, Psalm 86:17 says, "Show me a **sign of your favor**...that you, O Lord, give me comfort and help." Jesus teaches, "No sign shall be given to this generation, except the **sign of Jonah**" (Mark 16:14). As Jonah was in the belly of a sea creature for three days before appearing again, so Christ is buried in the earth before rising on the third day.

**Psalm 86**

The theme of the psalm this week is a common theme throughout the Book of Psalms: **A cry to God for help in a time of need**. "Hearken, O Lord, to my prayer and attend to the sound of my pleading", and again, "Turn toward me and have pity on me." After making the appeal for help, the Psalmist then gives reasons why the Lord should answer his call for help. The main argument he uses is **the goodness of the Lord**. "O Lord, you are **good and forgiving, full of mercy** to all who call on you." And again, "Among the gods **there is none like you**, O Lord, nor works to compare with yours."

The other argument in favor of God's mercy is more surprising: the holiness of the one asking. "Preserve my life, for **I am holy**. Save your servant who trusts in you." If we take literally the inscription of the Psalm which says "A prayer of David", it is even more surprising, since we know how King David was guilty of adultery and murder, the sins which occasioned Psalm 51: "My transgressions, truly I know them; my sin is always before me." As Jesus fulfilled all the promises made to David, so we also see that **this Psalm fits perfectly on the lips of Jesus**. He pleaded with God, not only on behalf of his own life, but







# Top 10 Things to know

For Returning to Public Mass

**1 DISPENSATION**

The dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass is extended through September 6, 2020.



**2 BE PATIENT AND CHARITABLE**

The guidelines for returning to Mass may seem extreme to some and too little for others. Please be considerate of how those around you may feel.



**3 CAPACITY**

Parishes are not to exceed 25% capacity.

**4 STAY INFORMED**

Visit your parish website and review all parish communication so you are informed of the specific procedures at your parish.



**5 WASH YOUR HANDS**

Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds (or while praying the Hail Mary) before leaving home.

**6 SANITIZE**

Use hand sanitizer upon entering the church. If able, carry your own sanitizer.

**7 WEAR A MASK**

Masks/face coverings should be worn by those medically able.



**8 DISTANCE**

A distance of six feet should be maintained between persons of different households.

**9 CONTACT FREE**

The Sign of Peace should remain a contact-free gesture.



**10 HOLY COMMUNION**

Keep your mask until after you say "Amen" then adjust to receive the Eucharist.

**RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION**

Holy Communion will be distributed only under the Species of the Sacred Host. You may receive either on the tongue or in the hand. Please remove any masks and gloves as you approach the minister.

Pause at the mark on the floor, the reverence and the verbal exchange should take place 6 feet away: Bow – "The Body of Christ" – "Amen" – then step forward to receive.

If you receive in the hand, please approach the priest (or deacon or EMHC), place your right hand under your left hand creating a sort of throne upon which to receive the Lord. After receiving Jesus in your hand, step to the side, and place the Sacred Host gently in your mouth, making sure to consume the Sacred Host before stepping away. Then, simply replace your mask and return prayerfully to your seat.

If you choose to receive on the tongue please remove your mask before approaching. Bow slightly or kneel as the priest or minister elevates the Sacred Host and says "The Body of Christ." Respond "Amen." Then extend your tongue so that the tip of your tongue is past your bottom lip and hold it steadily there as the Sacred Host is placed on your tongue. If done while not moving one's head or tongue while receiving, the risk of direct contact is minimized. In addition to the reverence given, kneeling also presents a more advantageous angle for the priest or minister to place the Sacred Host on your tongue without contact. After receiving, replace your mask and return prayerfully to your pew.
