Dear friends of St. Ann,

It's official, summer is over. As if on cue, the weather has gone cool and wet. For many of us, it seems too soon. As we get into the autumn months, we are drawn to various mysteries of our redemption. The month of September, for instance, is traditionally a time for meditation on the seven sorrows of Mary and the prayers and devotions related to them. In the meditation on the Seven Sorrows, Catholics consider the ways in which Mary shared the weight of the Passion of her Son Jesus. If you aren't familiar with these, they are: 1. The prophecy of Simeon. (Luke 2:34, 35) 2. The flight into Egypt. (Matthew 2:13, 14) 3. The loss of the Child Jesus in the temple. (St. Luke 2: 43-45) 4. The meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross. 5. The Crucifixion. 6. The taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross. 7. The burial of Jesus. Especially in this season of stress and struggle, this devotion is a moving way to consider the works of our redemption and to pray interceding for the suffering and sorrowful of the world.

September, because in 2020 nothing happens in the usual time, is also the



kickoff of our abbreviated Bishop's Annual Appeal. This appeal helps fund the ministries and services of the Diocese of Kalamazoo in the nine counties in southwest Michigan. This includes education of seminarians and deacon candidates, the continuing support and training of priests, support of Catholic schools, ministry to the growing Hispanic and Latino communities in our diocese, ministry to persons with disabilities, and much more. Given the extreme circumstances of this year, the parish goals set last year are the same for this year. Our goal at St. Ann is \$115,818. I am pleased to hear that St. Ann has a strong history of meeting and indeed exceeding our goal year in and year out. I hope you will help make this year another such year. Our 2020 Gala has been moved to the fall and we are going to have our event online. We still have many fun activities planned and we invite you to join us online for a wonderful time.

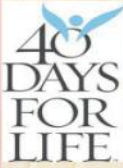

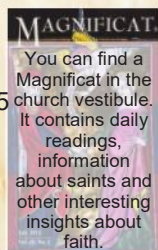
