



THE HISTORY OF THE ST. JOSEPH ALTAR

The St. Joseph Altar is Sicilian in origin. During a terrible famine, the people of Sicily pleaded to Saint Joseph, their patron saint, for relief. Saint Joseph answered their prayers and the famine ended. In gratitude, they prepared a table with foods they had harvested. After paying homage to St. Joseph, the food was distributed to the less fortunate.

HOW IS THE ALTAR MADE?

- Symbols of St. Joseph, such as lilies, staffs, sandals, saws, and hammers are used.
- The Altar is set up in three tiers, representing the Holy Trinity.
- No meat is prepared for the Altar. This is probably because St. Joseph's Feast falls in the Lenten Season and also because meat was a rarity to the Sicilian peasants.
- Fresh fruit represents the abundance of food and the end of the famine.
- Twelve whole fish represent the apostles.
- Fava beans were a common food for cattle, but the peasants of Sicily resorted to eating the beans in order to survive. They act as a reminder of God's provisions.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

The solemnity of St. Joseph falls on Friday, March 19th during this year of St. Joseph as proclaimed by Pope Francis. To honor St Joseph, the St. Ann chapter of the Knights of Columbus will be making spare ribs and mac & cheese for take out. You can place and pick up your order between 6:30-7:30 P.M. in the social hall. The projected price is \$10 with profits going to seminarians.

Stations of the cross will still happen beforehand on March 19th at 6:00 P.M.

Unlike a feast day (ex. St Patrick), where the Bishop may offer a dispensation during a Friday of Lent to eat meat, a solemnity automatically carries a dispensation according to canon law.

"Abstinence from meat, or from some other food as determined by the Episcopal Conference, is to be observed on all Fridays, unless a solemnity should fall on a Friday." (Canon 1251)


