**A CONVERSATION WITH FATHER TOM
by Mark Sundberg (LCA 7th Grade Student)**

I had the privilege to interview the pastor of this parish, Father Tom McNally, in order to have a clearer understanding of his vocation story and to learn a little bit about the life of a priest.

Father Tom was born and raised in Kalamazoo, by his parents, alongside his brother who is 4 years younger than him. He grew up in a Catholic family, that developed in the faith as he grew older. He attended Saint Monica school, and later Hackett High School. His hobbies as a child included being a member of Boy Scouts, reading, and playing video games. His most fulfilling hobby was altar serving. A hobby his whole family shared was traveling, especially on road trips. In fact, they had visited all 50 states while he was still at home.

When I asked Father Tom who he looks up to, his answer was his mom, because of her sacrifice and evident love for him. He said he began to discern the priesthood at the age of seven. Although he dated a girl in high school, the relationship did not last long and again, he felt called to serve God, which led to his ordination.

He said the part of our Catholic faith that he feels most drawn to is defending the proofs for the existence of God, as well as how deeply intellectual our faith truly is. Father Tom said that the most interesting aspect in the life of a priest is administering the sacraments to people, while seeing the effect of the Holy Spirit working through him. He admitted that even though the priesthood is a wonderful way of life it comes with a sacrifice, which is not being able to have a family. It is this church community that has become his family.

Father Tom said the meaning of priesthood is to have love for Christ's heart, to know the truth, to instruct others in it, and to be a witness of Christ. His message to any young man who is discerning the priesthood is to try his hardest to grow in holiness and to be open to hearing God's voice.



What a blessing the St. Ann parishioners and school families received this past weekend. Bishop Bradley came last Sunday to install Father Tom as the pastor of St. Ann parish. Congratulations Father Tom!




Spring Clean-up & prayer night



FROM THE DIOCESE

The normal expectations regarding the practice of the faith are now in effect, which includes the obligation to participate, in-person, in the celebration of Holy Mass each weekend for all who are able to do so.

Additionally, in light of the new CDC guidelines, and taking into account the growing numbers of people becoming fully vaccinated, the following changes to liturgical worship at Parishes are now in effect.

- Outdoor Mass attendees do not need to wear Masks; social distancing is still advised with the exception of households.
- Parishioners are not required to wear masks for indoor worship. However, those that are unvaccinated are asked to continue to wear their masks, for their own protection as well as the protection of others.
