NORTH WOODS FAVORITES

Cross in the Woods-Indian River: The 55 foot bronze crucifix is an awe inspiring rendering of Christ. There are also many other shrines (e.g. Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Shine), and a religious doll museum.

St. Mary/St. Charles-Cheboygan: The parishes in the north east corner of Michigan date back to the early missionary activities of Fredrick Baraga, who established the first church in the area in 1859.

St. Anne Church-Mackinac Island Submerge yourself in the history of the Catholic faith. Because of the work of Jesuit Priests, since the 1670's the presence of Roman Catholicism has endured in the Straits of Mackinac. Attend Mass at St. Anne church and visit the reconstructed historical St. Anne at Colonial Michilimackinac.


