Dear Friends in Christ:

Once again, The Church of Saint Ann will dedicate the month of September for 30 Days of Peace in response to the constant violence facing our world. We ask that during this month you purposefully devote some time to peace: use your actions, words, and prayers to further this cause.

You will notice small changes in our songs, prayers and atmosphere to promote peace.

Beginning the first weekend of September, our response to the Prayers of the Faithful will be sung: "Make me an instrument of your peace."

Reflections and prayers of peace will line the walls of the Gallery of Lights.

We invite individuals, particularly our young people and families to write poems of peace.

These poems can be written in three different styles: Haiku, Diamante and Acrostic.

Some poems will be printed in the bulletin.

September 5<sup>th</sup> is the Feast Day of Mother Teresa.

September 21<sup>st</sup> is the International Day of Peace.

### WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF THE EARTH

In 2015 Pope Francis, in conjunction with the Eastern Orthodox Church and the World Council of Churches, declared September 1 as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of the Earth. He stated that "as Christians we wish to contribute to resolving the ecological crisis which humanity is presently experiencing. In doing so, we must first rediscover in our rich spiritual patrimony the deepest motivation for the care of creation." For believers in Jesus Christ, "the life of the spirit is not dissociated from the body or from nature or from worldly realities, but lived in them, in communion with all that surrounds us." The ecological crisis "thus summons us to a profound spiritual conversion . . . for living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to the life of virtue; it is not an optional or secondary aspect of our Christian experience." (Laudato Si)



*The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation offers us an opportunity to reaffirm our vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork entrusted to our care, and to implore God's help for the protection of creation. The celebration of this day will be a valuable opportunity to bear witness to our communion with other churches at a time when all Christians are faced with the same decisive challenges.*

Therefore, on Friday, September 1, all members of the parish are encouraged to join Christians worldwide by saying the following prayer:

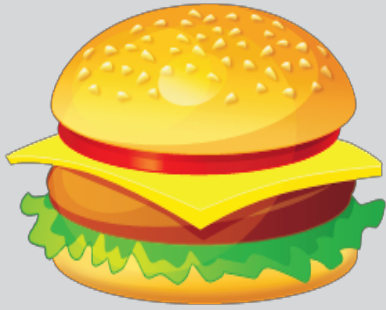
