Dear Friends,

September is up and our parish is getting pretty busy again both at church and at school. I hope everyone has had a good summer and is invigorated both body and spirit to carry on once again our tasks and responsibilities in bringing up our faith alive and vibrant in our parish.

Speaking of faith, please be reminded that our Religious Education classes will begin this September 15th. If you have not already enrolled, please send in your registration form to the Parish Office or directly to the Religious Education Office. I am happy to inform you this school year 2019-2020 our Religious Education Program will be led, guided, spirited and directed by a highly qualified and a very able person who has a Master's degree in this field of Religious Education (Catechesis) and Theology and is a Master of Divinity. Please welcome MR. GARY MACCARONI. He will be our Acting Director of Religious Education (DRE) in addition to his role as Pastoral Associate.

On this same day of September 15th, as we begin RE Classes, our Annual Parish Family Picnic will also take place. GOSPEL

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
September 8, 2019

Lk. 14:25-33

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.' Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms. In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple."

REFLECTION

What does it take to be a disciple of Jesus? A couple of weeks ago, we learned it takes discipline, a word derived from the same Latin root, disciplina, which means teaching or instruction. A new school year has just begun for many of us. What an appropriate time to act as a student, eager to learn what it takes to follow the Lord.

SEPTEMBER BEGINS 30 DAYS OF PEACE

“Light is greater than darkness, love is stronger than hate, and God is greater than evil.” - excerpted from *The Transformative Power of Faith* by Grayson Warren Brown

Eighteen years ago, our country was irrevocably changed by the catastrophic events of September 11. As a faith community, our response was to pray for peace. In August of 2002, as our community prepared to observe the first anniversary of the 9/11 attacks, parishioners gathered for the simple meditative work of creating peace cranes as a memorial and a constant reminder of the responsibility that we all share to work for peace and elimination of violence in all forms. We have hung this Peace Mobile every year since then; many of the same peace cranes still make up the mobile. May the Peace Crane Mobile, our parish memorial to 9/11, inspire all to work for peace and non-violence in word and in deed.

Take a few moments to recite this prayer from Fr. Mychal Judge: **“Lord, take me where you want me to go, let me meet who you want me to meet, tell me what you want me to say, and keep me out of your way.”**
