GOSPEL

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 29, 2021 - Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

When the Pharisees with some scribes who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus, they observed that some of his disciples ate their meals with unclean, that is, unwashed, hands. —For the Pharisees and, in fact, all Jews, do not eat without carefully washing their hands, keeping the tradition of the elders. And on coming from the marketplace they do not eat without purifying themselves. And there are many other things that they have traditionally observed, the purification of cups and jugs and kettles and beds. — So the Pharisees and scribes questioned him, “Why do your disciples not follow the tradition of the elders but instead eat a meal with unclean hands?” He responded, “Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, as it is written: *This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts.* You disregard God’s commandment but cling to human tradition.”

He summoned the crowd again and said to them, “Hear me, all of you, and understand. Nothing that enters one from outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile.

“From within people, from their hearts, come evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance, folly. All these evils come from within and they defile.”

REFLECTION

The greatest gift each of us has ever received was the gift of life itself. That gift was given to us most directly by our parents, whose life in turn was given to them by their parents, and so on. But ultimately the author of all life, the giver of every great gift, is God. We come together today in thanksgiving for that precious gift, which led to the gift of eternal life, promised by God’s Son to all who follow him.

A LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION IS GOD CALLING YOU TO SERVE AS A CATECHIST?

Faith is a gift from God. However, faith needs to be nourished if it is to develop and bear fruit in our lives.

As we begin to gather again for worship, and the building up of the community, we are very excited to get going again with in-person faith formation of our young parishioners, and we have started planning for a new year of religious education. ***To do this well, and develop faith, we are in need of new catechists, and so I want to invite you to consider volunteering for this ministry. The church needs catechists for its health, growth and vitality.***

Simply put, a catechist is someone who, in the name of the Church, presents the story of our Catholic faith to people in age appropriate format. In the words of Pope Francis, a catechist keeps the memory of God alive, in themselves and they are able to revive it in others.

No prior experience is necessary. Most of our catechists do not have advanced degrees in teaching. Perhaps you do not feel that your faith is strong, or deep, enough. That's OK. Time and time again, new catechists marvel at how much teaching the faith to the children or teens has strengthened their own faith. Perhaps you are intimidated about what to say or how to teach to a group of children or teens you do not know at all. Not to worry, you do not work alone. We will orient you and equip you with a user-friendly guidebook, and additional resources with many suggestions and helps for leading each session. You will also have a chance to speak with other, experienced catechists. Several catechists have had a few years' experience, and are more than happy to share tips and suggestions. Like anything else, once you get started you will get the hang of it and grow into it. We have also planned a catechist development evening for both new and experienced catechists on Tuesday, August 10, here in our community room, from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm. to orient us all to the new season.

If you feel that God is calling you to serve as a catechist, I can meet with you personally to acquaint you with the role. If you would like to be a catechist (an assistant or even a substitute catechist who fills in occasionally) or have questions, please call me directly at 609-882-6491, ext. 116.
