
Saint David Catholic Church October 13, 2024 Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Beginning the first of September 2024, the maintenance part time position will be opened to anyone who is qualified for the job. If you want to apply, please call the office during its hours of operation to express your interest. What are the criteria and requirements of the Maintenance Position?

- 1) The position is opened to any man who can do the job.
- 2) The maintenance guy is required to do the following:
- a) To take care of the Church and rectory, parish hall and Marais grounds.
- b) To pay attention to what needs to be fixed or repaired in all buildings.
- c) To maintain the parish car such as: oils changes, washing, etc.
- d) To make sure both parish hall and Marais buildings are cleaned for weekend use.
- e) To put out the garbage every Wednesday for pick up Thursday morning.
- f) To open and close the St. David School Gymnasium whenever there is an event.
- g) To do inventory, especially for the rectory, such as bulbs, tools, etc.


Youth and Young Adult Corner
