

ALMSGIVING - ALL SAINTS PARISH MEAL PROGRAM

This year's Lumen Christi Lenten Project will benefit All Saints Parish Meal Program. The All Saints Meal Program is available year-round on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:00 - 6:00 PM. The Hot Meal Program serves nearly 1,200 meals a month for the surrounding community and within the central City of Milwaukee.

There are two ways that Lumen Christi parishioners can help:

- 1. Donate. The annual cost of the program is \$150,000. Donations can be made by writing a check to Lumen Christi with "All Saints Parish Meal Program" in the memo line or by donating online via the Lenten page on Lumen Christi's website.
- 2. Volunteer. Parishioners are asked to sign up to serve meals on Tuesdays and Thursdays during Lent. You can sign up via the parish website's Lenten page. Note: you can still sign up to volunteer on Tuesday evening and make it back to Lumen Christi to hear the Soup and Substance speaker.


CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CENTER
