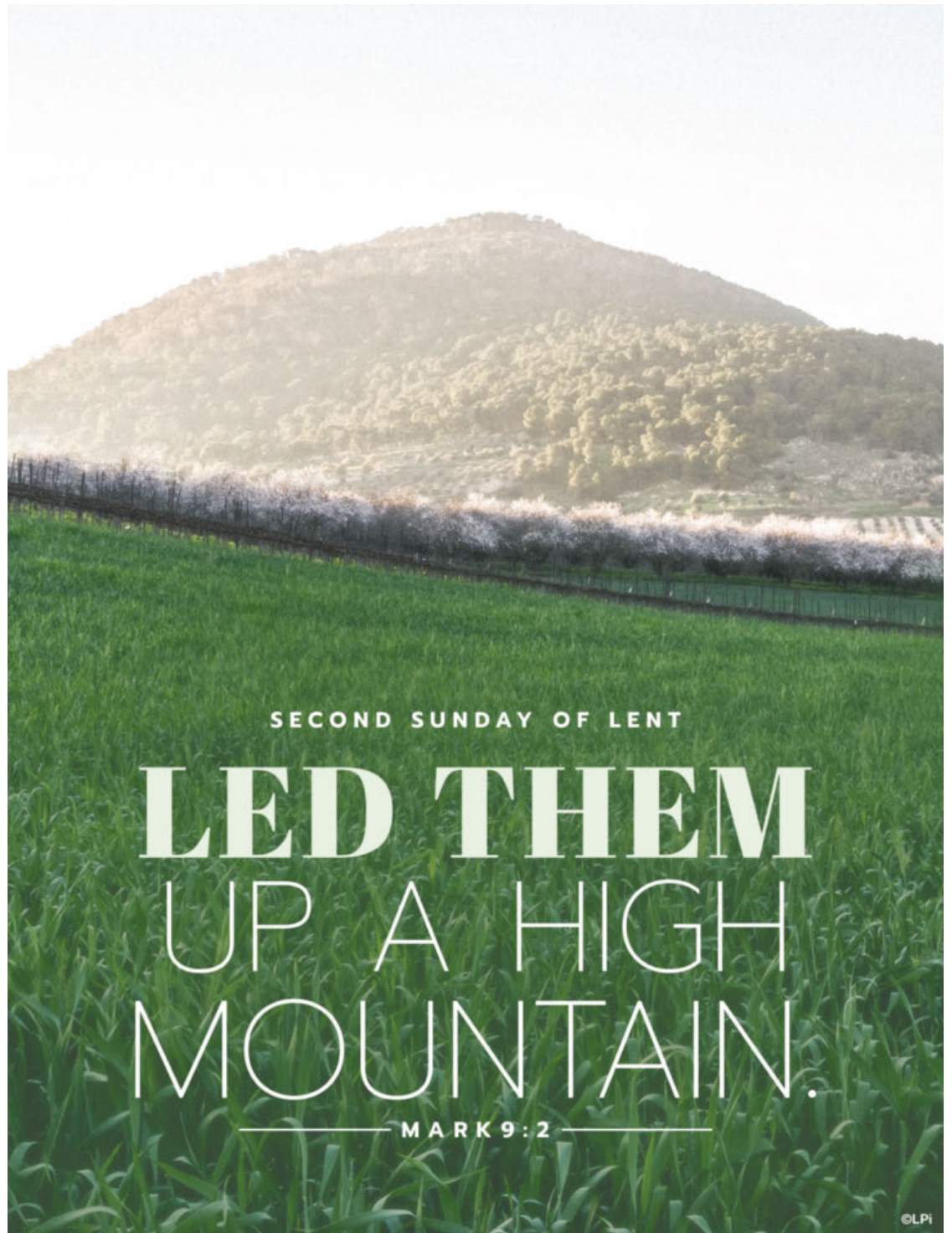

ALMSGIVING: ALL SAINTS PARISH MEAL PROGRAM

This year's Lumen Christi Lenten Project will benefit All Saints Parish Meal Program.

The All Saints Meal Program is available year-round on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:00 - 6:00 PM. The Hot Meal Program serves nearly 1,200 meals a month for the surrounding community and within the central City of Milwaukee.

There are two ways that Lumen Christi parishioners can help:

- 1. Donate.** The annual cost of the program is \$150,000. **Donations can be made by** writing a check to Lumen Christi with "All Saints Parish Meal Program" in the memo line or by donating online via the Lenten page on Lumen Christi's website.
- 2. Volunteer.** Thank you to everyone who has already signed up to volunteer at the All Saints Meal Program during this Lenten season! At the time this bulletin was printed, almost all of the volunteer slots were full. Please know that the meal program operates year-round and is always in need of volunteers.
