THE GREAT TASK OF BEING THEOTOKOS



Mary was a young woman growing up in Nazareth. One day, the archangel Gabriel appeared to her, and in her great "fiat" she agreed to become the mother of God. It's likely that most people knew her as just another girl. Who would expect that she would become a mother to God Himself? But she would raise the Messiah, the Anointed One, the Savior of the world. God, pouring out His great love, chose to give this woman an extraordinary role in salvation for which she will be remembered forever.

She became a herald of hope and redemption, not in words alone like the prophets, but in the very person of Jesus Christ, Emmanuel. Mary, giving life to God in her womb, introduced the new life to this world that it had been longing for. She brought a joy to others that was so strong even the unborn St. John the Baptist was able to rejoice in it. For this we call her Theotokos, or God-bearer.

This great task of bringing hope and joy to the world by giving others the opportunity to encounter Christ was not completed by Mary. God calls each of us in our own way to be a sort of Theotokos by proclaiming the Good News to those in need.

Somehow, God has chosen me to participate in my role as Theotokos in an even physical way - not in giving birth to Jesus, but bringing Him into the world, Body and Blood, at every Mass.

I'm grateful to God for the way He has chosen me to serve Him, especially in these past couple years at Lumen Christi. I also want to thank all of you for the ways we have helped each other grow in our mission of bearing God and His light to the world. What a blessing it is that God chooses each of us ordinary people to do the extraordinary as we bring Christ to others, and come closer to Him ourselves each day of our lives.


YOUTH MINISTRY
