






SUPPORT SHAMROCK DINNER & AUCTION



ST. VINCENT DE PAUL'S 2025 IMPACT

The District Council of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Ozaukee County consists of our Fredonia/Belgium, Port Washington/Saukville, Grafton, Mequon and Cedarburg St. Vincent de Paul Conferences.

- These five conferences provide neighbors in need, homeless, and jail releasee support for all of Ozaukee County.
- These works of charity are funded in part through our success in sales of donated items to our Port Washington Thrift Store.
- In addition to funding the good works of the conferences, our Thrift Store provides essential goods, such as clothes, shoes, housewares, and furniture to those we are helping.

As our founder, Blessed Frédéric Ozanam, said, "No work of charity is foreign to the Society." **Whether you volunteer at our store, donate goods for resale, or provide cash donations through the parish, please know that you are a vital part of our mission! We could not conduct our works of charity without your thoughtful consideration.**

Over the past year, SVdP members of the Ozaukee Council made close

to **400 home visits, assisting over 800 of our neighbors in need with financial help totaling over \$200,000.** This assistance included rent, utilities, food, transportation, and other needs. We have also provided some of these same neighbors with **over \$23,000 of our thrift store care cards** used for their family clothing and household needs.

We are so grateful that God has not only called us to serve our neighbors in need, but has provided us with your generous support that allows us to help those in need succeed in helping themselves.

As a sign of our deep appreciation, we are hosting hospitality after the Saturday 4:30 PM Mass and the Sunday 7:30 AM Mass while assisting with the hospitalities after the 9 & 11 AM Masses this weekend. Members of our SVdP conference will be available to answer any questions and we hope that you might consider joining our conference to learn about the spiritual aspect of our society as well as help serve our neighbors in need.




BECOMING A CATHOLIC IS A JOYOUS EXPERIENCE! Some receive this gift while they are infants, while others come into the Catholic community later in life.

VIRTUES, EXPLAINED!

Though it is often used as a synonym for happiness, joy has far more to do with the choices we make than the emotions we feel.

Joy is the experience of achieving what we most desire — and what we most desire is love. God made us in love and for love, and so, in the same way that a flower seeks the sunlight, our souls seek the warmth of true, selfless love. The virtue of joy, therefore, is a fruit of the virtue of love, or charity (CCC 1829).

"We are meant to have our human joys: the joy of living, the joy of love and friendship, the joy of work well done," said Saint Pope John Paul II. "We who are Christians have a further cause for joy: like Jesus, we know that we are loved by God our Father. This love transforms our lives and fills us with joy." ©LPI






