WELCOME, FR. PATRICK!

This past week Fr. Patrick Behling begun his ministry at Lumen Christi as our new associate pastor for the next three years. To learn more about him, check out his biography below!



THE VERY REV. FR. PATRICK BEHLING, KCHS, CHM

A native of Whitefish Bay, Fr. Patrick Behling was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee in 2016. He has served as associate pastor at St. Charles in Hartland, St. Teresa of Calcutta in North Lake, St. Mary's Visitation in Elm Grove, and Holy Family in Fond du Lac.

In addition to his parish work, Fr. Behling is an academic theologian by training. Recent research interests include Christology, ecclesiology, and the theology of the priesthood. He holds degrees from St. Olaf College, Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology, and the University of Saint Mary of the Lake.

Fr. Behling is a knight commander of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre and a magistral chaplain of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta. These two orders of knighthood date back to the Crusader period and today provide generous material and spiritual support to Christians in the Holy Land and to the poor and sick, respectively.

Prior to becoming a priest, he served as a U.S. Senate Page and member of the Senate floor staff. He is a devoted Brewers fan, an avid reader, and a hobbyist woodworker. Someday, he will complete his quest to visit all thirty major league baseball stadiums.

INTRODUCING THE WOW PROJECT

A SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE BY TEENS, FOR TEENS!

WOW stands for **Walk On Water**, highlighting our Faith in Christ and our aspiration to follow in His footsteps, particularly in the way He loved and served others. Jesus told His disciples, "Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant.... For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:42-45)

So far, the WOW Project is composed of 10 student leaders (and several adult mentors) who coordinate opportunities for high school students in Mequon to come together as a community to serve the community. We partner with several local charitable organizations, and also aim to serve the parish and individuals in the Mequon area and beyond.

We launched our first service project this spring, working with the high schoolers in Catholic Formation to make over 300 sandwiches for Guest House of Milwaukee. We have plans to increase our impact this summer and through the school year with various opportunities for students to get involved.

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Fear No One

In the 1883 painting "Mass in a Connemara Cabin," a small congregation of shabbily dressed faithful is huddled together in a sparsely appointed room. A priest extends his hand over them in blessing. One woman presses her forehead to the ground in prayer.

This painting, created in 1883 by Aloysius O'Kelley, depicts a "station Mass," offered for the community in a private home. Though this practice originated in the period of the Penal Laws, when Catholic worship was illegal in Ireland, it persisted even after the "emancipation" of Catholics in the 19th century.

I have used quotation marks around the word "emancipation" because we must never forget that just because something is made legal does not mean it is made popular. And it certainly is not made safe.

In the moments that pass immediately after this scene concludes, the altar candles will be extinguished and the

faithful will disperse, carrying the Body and Blood of Christ into a world suspicious of him, suspicious of them.

And yet here they are, kneeling. Foreheads pressed to the floor.

This painting sits on my family's prayer table as a call to reflection. I make my living writing Catholic things for Catholic publications. The people who read what I write are bound to agree with me — they're usually reading my words in a church. I must confess that in my personal life, I am far less bold. I fear controversy. I dread giving offense. I buckle beneath the weight of discipleship.

It doesn't matter that most Americans identify as "Christians" — the world we face when we leave Mass is every bit as resentful of true Catholic teaching as the world that lies beyond O'Kelley's Connemara cottage. And while I do not fear those who can kill my body, I do fear those who can kill my reputation.

"Mass in a Connemara Cabin" illustrates how my ancestors worshiped: in secret, in shadow.

I worship in the daylight.

Which of us acknowledges Christ more fully? More courageously?

VIRTUES, EXPLAINED!

There was a certain sister in the Carmelite convent who particularly tried the patience of St. Therese of Lisieux.

But instead of avoiding this person, St. Therese instead made a point of smiling at her whenever the two met.

"Charity must not consist in feelings, but in works," wrote St. Therese. "I set myself to doing for this Sister what I would do for the person I loved the most." In doing so, she learned to see "Jesus hidden in the depths" of this woman's soul.

St. Therese was growing in the virtue of affability when she did this. Affability is attached to justice, writes St. Thomas Aquinas, and demands "that we behave pleasantly to those among whom we dwell." (*Sum.*, II:II, 114, Art. 2)

In being affable, we make ourselves friendly, approachable, and agreeable to those around us, regardless of how they make us feel. "How good and how pleasant it is when brothers dwell together as one," writes King David in Psalm 133. ©LPi

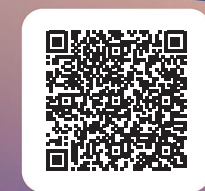
