EXPLORING OUR SPIRITUAL HOME

Every little detail in a Catholic church is intentional and Lumen Christi is no exception. In 2019, the church underwent an extensive renovation. It is easy to walk past these sacred details, so in this new series we're taking a closer look at our spiritual home.



THE PASCHAL HEARTH

All those who approach Lumen Christi Church from the east pass the Paschal hearth. The fire of this hearth at the Easter Vigil represents the Light of Christ entering the world, dispelling the darkness.

Easter Vigil

Every Easter Vigil begins with the assembly gathering around the Paschal hearth for what is called the Service of Light. The priest blesses the fire, carves a cross and other symbols into the Paschal Candle, and then lights it.

The Paschal Candle is then processed into the church with the assembly. The words: **"Lumen Christi! Deo Gratias!"** are proclaimed three times. This means "Light of Christ! Thanks be to God!" Throughout Sacred Scripture and the Liturgy, the image of Christ's light dispels the darkness.

Bonus:

What does Paschal mean?

Paschal is another word for Easter!

REGISTER FOR CATHOLIC FORMATION TODAY!

We are again using Realm Connect (parish database system) as the platform to register for Catholic Formation. As a registered parish member, your information is already in our database.

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. When logged into Realm Connect, click on Events in the left column.
2. This year we have separated registration for Child Ministry (4K-5th grade) and Youth Ministry (6th - 11th grade). Click on the desired registration and begin to register your children.
3. Before you submit: you can decide if you will pay today in full or partial payment (min \$50) OR pay 'in person' with cash or check. **Payments online cannot be combined if registering in both CM & YM; however you may send in one payment with a check or cash.** *If you wish to pay online, and your family qualifies for the maximum out of pocket, please email Megan Schulz, to apply the discount.*

LC CEMETERY BURIAL SITES DECORATIONS

It has become more common to place lovely live or faux flowers at the cemetery near loved one's burial sites. Please know that we do have to either move most of these to near the well because they impede grass mowing and trimming, or remove them completely after a period of time.

In addition, these items damage the grass leaving an unsightly hole once the item is removed. We also discourage planted "gardens" unless you plan to personally maintain the planted flower garden by weeding and watering regularly.

"Private prayer is like straw scattered here and there. If you set it on fire it makes a lot of little flames, but gather these straws into a bundle and light them, and you get a mighty fire, rising like a column into the sky; public prayer is like that." (St. John Vianney)

Every Vincentian knows the power of a single personal encounter; the knock on the door, the listening, the quiet prayer at the kitchen table, the rent check that keeps a family housed one more month. That visit matters deeply to the person in front of you. St. John Vianney reminds us that when these little flames are joined, something more than the sum of the parts begins to happen.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

A man recently told me he was losing patience with the Church. **"It's supposed to be God's Kingdom on earth,"** he said, **"but it's full of contradictions and hypocrisy. Why can't the Church just be better?"** That last word landed with a judgmental thud. It hurt. Because at times the Church can look painfully ordinary, even disappointing.

But Jesus' parables in today's Gospel meet that frustration head-on. He says, **"The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field,"** yet the weeds grow up with the wheat, and the master allows both to grow together until harvest. To his listeners, this sounded strange, even offensive. They expected God's reign to be pure, powerful, and glorious, anything but

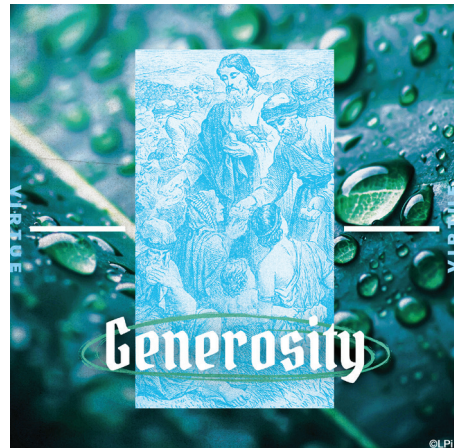
mixed up, hidden, or small.

Jesus is showing us something essential. The Kingdom always begins small and grows amid imperfection. Grace and weakness exist side by side until the harvest. That is why the Church often looks messy. Yet within that mess, God's quiet work continues. The weeds do not stop the wheat from growing.

When we see the Church's flaws or our own, it helps to remember that this is exactly the field in which Christ chose to plant. The miracle is not that everything looks perfect, but that his Word keeps taking root anyway.

Lord, give me patience with Your field, the Church. Help me see Your hidden life growing even among the weeds. Amen.

But it certainly does describe the spirit with which we must live as Christians — and it is a generous spirit, a spirit of self-denial, a spirit that prioritizes the welfare of our brothers and sisters as it does our own.

Generosity is a fruit of the Holy Spirit, cultivated in our hearts by a closeness to the sacraments and a persistence in prayer: "The one who provides seed for sowing and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness." (2 Corinthians 9:10)

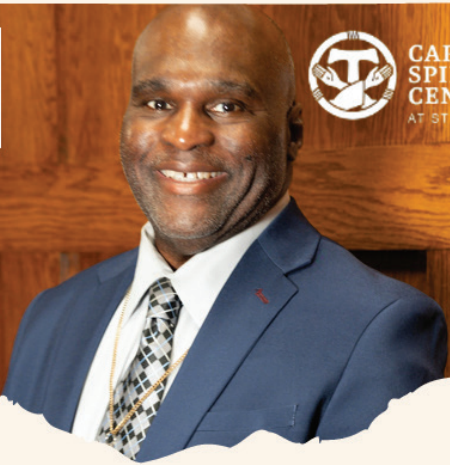
