Fall Bible Study – Lectio: Mary  
St. Jude's and Our Lady parishioners: This is a Bible Study you will NOT want to miss! What exactly is the Church's teaching on Mary? Do you get that deer-in-the-headlights look and kind of hem and haw when your non-Catholic family/friends ask you why you "worship" Mary? Would you like to be armed with ready answers to common misconceptions about Mary? What exactly is Mary's role in the Christian life? Would you like to develop a closer relationship with and a deeper love for our Blessed Mother but don't know where or how to start?

In Lectio: Mary, Dr. Brant Pitre insightfully examines the Biblical teaching of what Scriptures, the life of Christ, and the early Church Fathers reveal about Mary. By closing examining the connections between the Old and New Testaments, Dr. Pitre presents clear, easily-understood explanations about the life and identity of Mary, the Mother of God. Personal reflections will lead you into a deeper love for Mary and a clearer understanding of her role in your Christian life.

This is an 8-wk video program with discussion questions. Our first session will be Sunday, Nov 3, at St. Jude's at 7 p.m. Cost for participants is \$5.00!
