On Tuesday October 31st of this past week 12 parishioners along with Patti Wasserman and I made a pilgrimage to The Sorrowful Mother Shrine in Bellevue.

There we participated in Holy Mass, had the opportunity to Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Mass, and prayed the Holy Rosary on the Shrine grounds at the 13th Station of the Cross where Jesus is taken down from the Cross and placed in the arms of his Blessed Mother.

As it was the 47th day of the Rosary Novena for the defeat of Issue 1, we offered the Rosary for that intention through the Saint of the Day, Theresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein). In the Opening Prayer of the novena for that day we prayed "O Holy Mother, at thy feet I offered a crown of roses, golden roses to remind thee of the divine life which was opened to humanity through your family's suffering, the Glorious Mysteries of they heart." I lighted votive candles in the Shrine for all of the Parishioners of Saint Mary's and Saint Michael's. I also concelebrated the Holy Mass for the parishioners of both parishes.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptism - Please contact Dcn. Mike for information and to schedule, which for first-time parents includes an orientation to the Sacrament.

Confirmation - The normative time for Confirmation in the Diocese of Toledo is eighth grade. Please contact Patti Wasserman for more information.

Reconciliation - A priest is available after Tuesday Mass @ GB and after Friday Mass @ MV. Saturdays at 4:00pm in GB. and Sundays at 8:00am in MV.

Anointing of the Sick - Please contact Fr. Tad if you or a family member are critically ill, preparing for surgery, or are of advanced age and in need of this Sacrament. In case of an emergency outside of office hours, please press '8' when prompted by the automated phone system. This sacrament can be received many times throughout one's life, and is not reserved for end of life only.

Matrimony - Please contact either parish office at least six months before you hope to marry, and know that a wedding date cannot be set until a couple's freedom to marry has been determined in consultation with Fr. Tad or Dcn. Mike. Annulments, when necessary, may require 18-24 months to resolve.

Holy Orders - Please contact Dcn. Mike if you feel the Lord may be inviting you to a vocation to the priesthood, the diaconate, or religious life.

Holy Communion for the Homebound - Please contact either parish office if you are unable to come to Mass and would like to receive Holy Communion in your home or care facility.
