Dear Friends

I held you all in prayer during my four day pilgrimage to from Bono Our Lady of Mount Carmel to Our Lady of Consolation Shrine in Carey. It was very rich in the presence of Mary and her maternal and loving spirit, in

priestly fraternity with my two brother priests, and in physical work for the Glory of God and vocations to the priesthood.

I took the opportunity to partake in the renewal of my consecration to Jesus



through Mary- which is 30 days of prayers and then a formal consecration. I will make the formal consecration at Our Lady Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral on October 7, which is the Feast Day of Our Lady of the Rosary. I was also ordained a priest in the Year of Our Lady of the Rosary, which was in 2003.

Walking with priests was incredible. We had tacos at the market in Lindsey one day for lunch and had sandwiches at the market in Old Fort another day for lunch. We stayed in rectories in Genoa, Fremont and Tiffin and had beautiful Masses with each other each day. People joined us all along the way for brief periods of the walk. The north coast inland trail from Genoa to Fremont was a walking highlight for me.

It was very physically demanding. Blisters on my feet did not start for me until the last day. We needed breaks as the days continued as we were walking. When I arrived at the host rectories I would lie immediately on the floor in exhaustion. We had some nice dinners with other brother priests who were hosts. It was the most

physically demanding thing I have done in my life next to the 26.2 full marathon I ran in Chicago in 2014.

Please pray for Deacon Mike and I this weekend as we spend three and a half days for a Cursillo retreat which we will make together with two men from our parishes in Tiffin.

Baptism - Please contact Dcn. Mike for information and to schedule, which for first-time parents includes an orientation to the Sacrament.

Confirmation - The normative time for Confirmation in the Diocese of Toledo is eighth grade. Please contact Patti Wasserman for more information.

Reconciliation - A priest is available after Tuesday Mass at Saint Michael and after Friday Mass at Saint Mary. Saturdays at 4:00pm at Saint Michael, and Sundays at 8:00am at Saint Mary.

Anointing of the Sick - Please contact Fr. Tad if you or a family member are critically ill, preparing for surgery, or are of advanced age and in need of this Sacrament. In case of an emergency outside of office hours, please press '8' when prompted by the automated phone system. This sacrament can be received many times throughout one's life, and is not reserved for end of life only.

Matrimony - Please contact either parish office at least six months before you hope to marry, and know that a wedding date cannot be set until a couple's freedom to marry has been determined in consultation with Fr. Tad or Dcn. Mike. Annulments, when necessary, may require 18-36 months to resolve.

Holy Orders - Please contact Fr. Tad, or Dcn. Mike if you feel the Lord may be inviting you to a vocation to the priesthood, the diaconate, or religious life.

Holy Communion for the Homebound - Please contact either parish office if you are unable to come to Mass and would like to receive Holy Communion in your home or care facility.
