Age 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ and Older IRA Charitable Contributions for Parish Bulletins

If you are 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ or older and have an IRA, there is a tax-saving way to benefit your favorite charities including our parish/diocese. Everyone that is 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ and older is required to withdraw a "Required Minimum Distribution" (RMD) from their IRA's. The diocese and all of our parishes are eligible to receive a tax-free distribution from IRA RMD's. If retirement funds are in another type of retirement account (such as 401k or 403b funds), or if a person is still working, this distribution cannot be initiated. However, these retirement funds could be transferred to an IRA, and then a distribution to a charity is allowed. In summary, using the RMD for a charitable donation gives donors an opportunity to support a cause they care about and at the same time achieve tax benefits on that part of their RMD. Some donors in our diocese are using this distribution option to pay their capital campaign pledge, their DDF gift, their parish offertory tithe, etc. For more information or if you have any questions, please contact Jan Smith, Director of Finance, at The Catholic Center (417) 866-0841.
