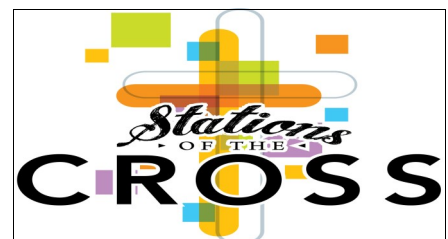

Parish Update

We've got quite a few projects in progress around the parish, and it's a good time for an update.

First is work on the new playground for the school. With all the rain we've had since finishing demolition in the fall, we haven't been able to complete the field. As soon as we get a decent dry spell, we'll begin filling in the holes. During that process we will also be doing some grading on the rest of the property to help with drainage. This means things are going to look worse before they get better. But that's the cost of doing things right the first time and not having to go back and fix it later.

Next up is the old furnace unit on the east side of church. As you've probably noticed, we've had some trouble with it this year. Our long-term plan was to replace it with a new unit, and so we decided at a recent finance committee meeting to do so now. We have the money and figured it's smarter to replace now instead of waiting for it to break completely.

This brings up the next point, which is the finance committee and parish council. When Fr Dominic and I first got here, we began work on splitting the parish council to form a finance committee. It is Church law that every parish have a finance committee, and we wanted to get us in compliance with that law. For information on how the finance committee works, see the diocesan guidelines posted on the bulletin board in the back of church.

Finally, the parish council came up with a prioritized list for parish improvements. The furnace was the first thing, and we already have the ball rolling on that one. Second was purchasing furniture for the Multipurpose room (which already has money earmarked). Next is completion of the playground. We will have the total amount raised to date for this project next week. Fourth is the sidewalks around the school, (which has money earmarked). And fifth is replacing some of the sidewalks around the church. Sixth is updating the rectory kitchen. Seventh is paving the small parking lot between the church and the parish center. Eighth is completion of the prayer garden, and ninth is paving of the big parking lot.

As you can imagine, getting through this list is going to take a few years at the very least. Things also may switch in priority as situations change, but this is the general road map. If you have any questions feel free to ask!
