## **Holy Communion for Homebound**

Parish members wishing to bring the Eucharist to family members or friends who are home bound due to illness, surgery, or safety precautions, please take note of the following information:

Several pyx (container for the Eucharist) can be found in the drawer of the table in the main entry of church, along with a communion service prayer card. Bring the pyx with you when receiving communion at mass, first opening the pyx and letting Father know how many host you will need **before** receiving communion yourself.

After leaving church, visit the person receiving communion as soon as possible. If for some reason, you are unable to bring communion to the person, consume the host yourself. Return the pyx to the drawer in the back of church the next time you attend mass.

Parish volunteers are also available to bring the Eucharist to the homebound. If you want to be added to the list, or know of someone who would appreciate a visit, either call the parish office or put their name and phone number in the Sunday collection basket.
