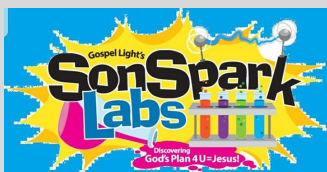
Rosary prayer group meets on Wednesdays at 11am. All are welcome and rosaries will be provided.
