OUR PARISH ROOTS

Over the years, St. Patrick's has provided pastoral care to Catholics in Cotton County– including Randlett, Devol, Taylor, Cookietown & Temple; Empire City & Comanche in Stephens County; Geronimo in Jefferson County.

Fr. Frederick Van derAa of Apache erected the first church and dedicated it to St. Luke on November 23, 1910. In 1927 Fr. Leo Claus promoted the construction of a new church. After 40 years of service the building was condemned as unsafe and construction of a new church was necessary.

On October 20, 1968, Bishop Reed dedicated the new church to the honor of St. Patrick.

St. Patrick Parishioners continue their journey of faith, worshiping daily in St. Patrick Church. OUR CAMPAIGN PARTICIPATION

St. Patrick welcomes the opportunity to participate in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City's campaign, *One Church, Many Disciples*.
