# **Campaign Progress**

• Parishes in Wave IV have raised nearly \$6.4 million to date; 64% of the wave goal.

- Congratulations to Sacred Heart, Mangum; St. Mary Assumption, Wakita; Ss. Peter and Paul, Hobart; St. Eugene, Weatherford; Holy Trinity, Okarche; St. Francis Xavier, Sulphur; and Blessed Sacrament, Thomas for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals!
- So far, 65 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$83.5 million to date. Every dollar raised over the challenge goal of \$80 million helps strengthen local parish and shared ministries!

### **Tips for Successful Visits**

Here are several tips to help ensure your visits with fellow parishioners are successful:

- During Visit—Encourage discussion and questions. It is not uncommon to encounter some negativity or misconceptions at the beginning of the visit. We want to be able to address the concerns during the visit before they receive the request letter.
- Verbalize the Request—Remember to verbalize a request for a 5-year commitment. Avoid just handing them their packet or dropping it off to them and trying to discuss it later. The best results come from discussing the request face to face.
- Encourage Prayerful Reflection—If the donor is ready to make a small pledge or a one-time gift, encourage them to take some time to pray about their decision. Encourage them to consider a pledge over 5 years that will be appropriate for them.
- Hold onto the Pledge Card—Follow-up by email, phone, or in person 5-7 days after the initial
  meeting. Encourage decisions within two weeks, this will keep the campaign fresh in their mind
  as they pray about their pledge and help to build consistent momentum. Complete the pledge
  card together when they have come to a decision.
