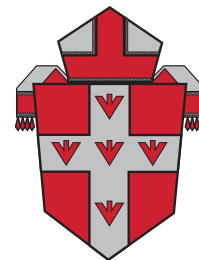
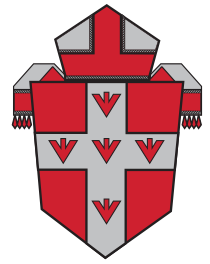

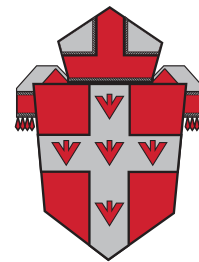


ACA PRAYER

WHAT IS THE ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL?

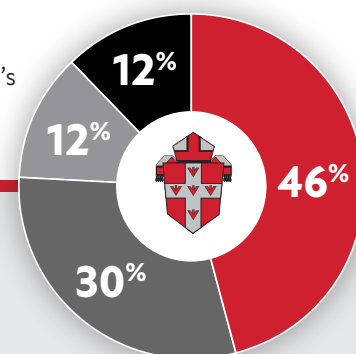
The **Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA)** is more than an archdiocesan fundraiser — it is a call to mission. It is an opportunity for every Catholic in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City to join in the Church's vital work of **spreading the Gospel and making disciples**.

The ACA supports **essential ministries, programs and services** that bring Christ's love to people in every corner of our archdiocese — from seminarians preparing for the priesthood, to faith formation for children and adults, to outreach through Hispanic and Native American ministry and much more. Every gift helps bring the light of Christ to our neighbors.

Your role in the Annual Catholic Appeal is not simply about asking for money — it's about inviting our parishioners to participate in the Church's mission to "Go Make Disciples." When people see the real lives being changed through their generosity, they begin to understand that their gift is not to a collection — but to a cause, to a mission, to Christ Himself.

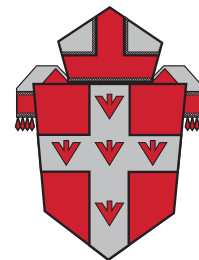

2026 THEME

We are going away from having a theme be the center of the appeal. This has caused confusion and we want parishioners to understand what the Annual Catholic Appeal is. Instead, our communication will be rooted in the reading from Commitment Weekend. This year, the first reading during Commitment Weekend comes from the prophet Isaiah:

“Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; you shall cry for help, and he will say: Here I am!” (Isaiah 58:9)

These words remind us that God hears the cries of his people and responds with love. Through the Annual Catholic Appeal, we are called to be part of that response—sharing Christ’s presence, compassion and hope with others. Each gift is more than a contribution: It is our answer to God’s call to serve.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACA COLLECTIONS & GIFT HANDLING

All ACA gifts should be mailed promptly to ensure speed, security and transparency. **Beginning in 2026, ACA gifts will be processed locally in Oklahoma City.** Please note there is a new mailing address for ACA gifts— **Please help us ensure this new address is used by discarding all previous ACA material.**

Gift Handling Procedures:

LOOSE CASH/COINS

- Count all loose cash and coins.
- Deposit the cash and coins into your parish account.
- Write a check drawn on your parish account for the corresponding amount, made out to Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, Memo Lin: Annual Catholic Appeal.
- Place the check in the prepaid return mailer or your own packaging with sufficient postage to the address listed above.

CHECKS WITHOUT ENVELOPES

- Bundle all loose checks (those not received in sealed envelopes) with rubber band.
- Attach transmittal form ([access at archokc.org/appeal/documents](https://www.archokc.org/appeal/documents)).
- Place the checks in the prepaid return mailer or your own packaging with sufficient postage to the address listed above.

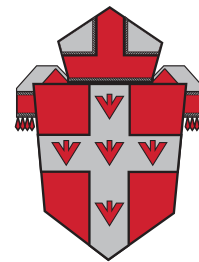
SEALED PLEDGE ENVELOPES

- Please DO NOT OPEN.
- Bundle with rubber band.
- Attach completed transmittal form.
- Place the bundles of sealed pledge envelopes in the prepaid return mailer or your own packaging with sufficient postage to the address listed above.

COMPLETED PLEDGE CARDS WITHOUT ENVELOPES

- You may receive some pledge cards without an envelope.
- Check to make sure your parish is correctly identified on each pledge card.
- Bundle loose completed pledge cards with a rubber band.
- Attach completed transmittal form to each bundle.
- Place the bundles of sealed pledge envelopes in the prepaid return mailer or your own packaging with sufficient postage to the address listed above.

Always mail gifts immediately so donors can be acknowledged promptly.



PARISH ROLES AND LEADERSHIP

ACA Leadership Team

It is recommended to create an ACA Leadership Team to help implement the appeal. This includes the pastor, Appeal Chair and administrative contact. The ACA Leadership Team helps execute ACA steps, encourages participation and communicates with parishioners.

- **Priests & Deacons**

Main leaders and advocates of ACA. Appoint Appeal Chair, encourage participation and support implementation.

- **Parish Appeal Chairperson**

Individual or small group of people. Serves as a partner to help pastor execute the ACA. Responsible for placing pledge envelopes and pens in pews before each Mass, works with ushers to ensure pledge envelopes are collected, provides a personal witness about the ACA to parishioners during Mass, invites and recruits more parishioners to participate.

- **Parish Administrative Contact** *(can be the same person as the Appeal Chair or someone new)*

Responsible for coordinating logistics at the parish including ensuring promotional materials are placed/used such as bulletin announcements, ACA video, QR sheets, posters, etc. Ensures gifts are mailed in a timely manner to: Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, Dept # 960658, Oklahoma City, OK 73196. Serves as liaison with Office of Stewardship & Development.

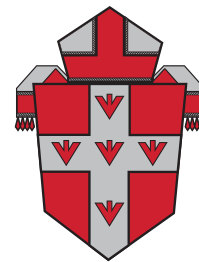
How can I better serve my parish by implementing the appeal as a pastor, staff or volunteer?

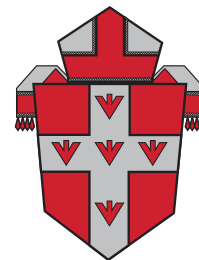
Commitment Weekend

The goal of Commitment Weekend is to distribute ACA materials to parishioners, share the impact of the ACA and encourage them to support the appeal. The success of your parish's Commitment Weekend is essential to the 2026 ACA. A strong Commitment weekend not only increases total contributions but also encourages more parishioners to participate, including first-time donors: **80% of first-time gifts come from in-pew.**

February 7 – 8, 2026

As with Introduction Weekend, there are a few things we ask you to do during and after to make your Commitment Weekend a success:

- Homily connects readings to ACA
- Pastor/Celebrant guides In-Pew Appeal using provided script
- Publish Bulletin Announcement #2
- Remind parishioners there are many ways to give:
 - **In pew response cards**
 - **Scanning the QR Pew Card to give securely online**
 - **Visit www.archokc.org/aca**
- Provide enough time for parishioners to make their gift
- Thank parishioners for their support and emphasize participation
- Collect sealed envelopes
- Include Special Intercession
- Send out email/social media reminder with ACA giving link: www.archokc.org/aca



FOLLOW-UP WEEKEND

Follow-Up Weekend

Thank those who have given and encourage those who have not yet made their gift to join their brothers and sisters in Christ in supporting the ACA.

February 14 – 15, 2026

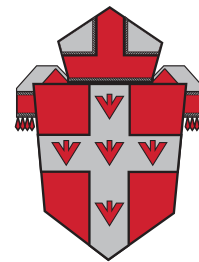
- Encourage 100% participation
- Publish Bulletin Announcement #3
- Include Special Intercession
- Thank parishioners who have already given
- Continue to provide envelopes, QR codes, and ACA video links
- After weekend masses, encouraged to collect extra envelopes and Bulletin sheets and save for later use

During the summer/August, parishes that are below 50% of goal, will be encouraged to hold a second Commitment Weekend.

For this second Commitment Weekend we ask:

- Choose a weekend (ideally by the middle of August)
- Promote in your bulletin, pulpit, social media and intercessions
- Place pledge envelopes in the pews or display the Appeal QR code
- Preach a personal, heartfelt homily — your voice makes the difference

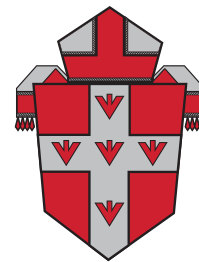

ARCHBISHOP'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

- Funding youth programs, parish ministries and urgent repairs for rural parishes

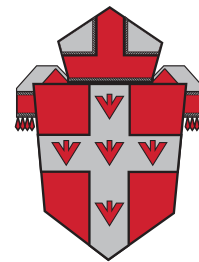

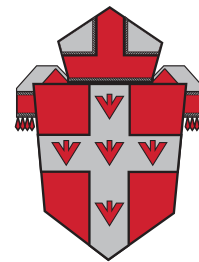
The goal as an archdiocese is to raise \$4.6 million and increase parishioner participation. If our parish meets our **participation goal, we have the opportunity to receive a grant back to our parish!** It is my hope that every household in our parish contributes to this year's effort.

Our parish goal this year is **<\$2026 Parish Goal>. I hope you will join me in helping to meet and exceed this year's goal!** The collective spirit we bring to this effort today will be a major step to our success with this year's appeal.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How are ACA funds used?

Q: Can I designate my donation?

A: No, ACA gifts are distributed based on ministry needs across the archdiocese.

A: Parishes may receive grants, parish resources, ministry training and other support directly from the archdiocese.

Q: How can I give?

A: Online, checks, cash, stock gifts, DAF, IRA distributions, or by phone.

Q: Will I receive a receipt?

A: Yes, every donor receives an acknowledgment letter from the archbishop immediately following the gift and a tax receipt in January of the following year from the Stewardship and Development office.
