

Easter Sunday is the holiest of all days in the Christian calendar. Why is that? Throughout Jesus' life, everybody was asking the question: "Who is this Jesus of Nazareth?" Many will admit that Jesus was a great teacher. Many will agree, like the Muslims, that Jesus was even a

great prophet. However, Jesus claimed to be more than this. He made some very outrageous claims. He claimed that and He and the Father were one. How arrogant! He said that we must eat His flesh and drink His blood. How disgusting! He said that He would rise from the dead after three days. How absurd! We should not be too hasty to judge those who put Jesus to death. Imagine if someone today was making the same claims and getting many people to follow him. We would consider that person a danger to society.

Please note that you must have previously completed the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Application on TADS to apply for the School Tuition Aid Program.
