#### From the Desk of Rev. Scott Holmer



As we come to the end of ordinary time, this Sunday we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. One of the acts of the King will be to separate the wicked from the righteous. At the end of the world,

Jesus will judge us.

For those who do not know Jesus, the prospect of judgment is frightening. Many go through life trying to avoid thinking about death and judgment. They go through life ignoring God and then cross their fingers and hope for the best in the afterlife. This leads to having a miserable life and a miserable afterlife. However, if we develop a friendship with Jesus, we are joyfully judged before we die. In the silence of prayer, by reading the scriptures, Jesus reveals to us how we can grow in holiness. He can reveal to us our sins and how we can improve. Through the Sacraments we can have our sins washed away in baptism, even deadly sins can be purged in Confession, and we can achieve union with God by consuming the Eucharist.
