

Pastoral Message from Fr. George for 10.13.23



As Christians we are called to pray for those in harm's way. This past Saturday, the Palestinian militant group Hamas brutally attacked Israel, with its fighters killing and raping residents, taking hostages, and killing and beheading babies. As of Tuesday night, reports indicated Hamas massacred more than 1,200. In addition to the Israeli casualties, Americans were killed and taken hostage. Hamas is sworn to Israel's destruction and seeks to replace it with an Islamic state. Please pray with me for God's mercy for those being persecuted:

In places where there is violence, bring peace. In places of spiritual darkness, bring the Light of Christ. In places of sadness, bring joy. In places of hate, bring love and reconciliation. And in places of despair, bring hope. All in all, we ask you to bless us with Your presence and make us faithful followers of Your Son, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Hear us, O God our Savior and help us, save us, have mercy on us and protect us by Your Grace.

For You are the King of Kings, the Provider of Peace, and the Savior of our souls and to You we give glory: to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and to the ages of ages. Amen!


Statement by His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew in Light of the Tragic Events in the Middle East (Sunday, October 8, 2023)



We are deeply grieved by the news coming from the suffering Middle East. We mourn the souls taken during the recent tragic events. May God's embrace comfort the grieving families.

Our thoughts and prayers are particularly with the civilians, who experience painful moments of anguish, terrorized by the eerie sound of the sirens and the imminent threat of the explosions, and especially with all the innocent children, who deserve to get raised in a truly "Promised Land" of peace and prosperity.

Amid anger and destruction, amid evil and bitterness, human beings are easily tempted to think and to act violently. While many deem violence as a necessary means of dispute resolution, we can never see it as part of God's good creation, nor can we ever approve the use of violence to pursue peace. Instead, we must look back to the "good" that God first created and the perfect peace to which he desires us to go, exhorting with the Psalmist: "Depart from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it" (Psalm 34:14). Besides, the struggle for peace is not only a divine commandment, but also a universal value and an essential precondition for the respect and protection of human dignity.



There are 9 minutes during the day that have the greatest impact on a child:

The first 3 minutes right after they wake up

 The 3 minutes after they come home from school.

 The last 3 minutes of the day before they go to bed.

Make those minutes special and help our children feel special, loved, and accepted.

~ Each day children need meaningful eye-to-eye conversations with a parent. It is especially important to slow down and look them in the eye. Listen and respond with love.

~ Hug your child, straighten her hair, pat him on the back and tell them how proud you are of him every day. A simple touch makes them feel connected to a parent in ways that words never will. Remember, actions speak louder than words!
