






Dear Father Tsahakis:

We thought that you, as a respected religious leader in your area, would find the following of interest. It involves the important role of a priest in America's democracy as envisioned by the United States' Founding Fathers. This is often misunderstood in our community.

We highlight this information as part of our work to help our church in Washington, DC for three generations and over 85 years. This includes our close coordination with the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America, primarily Father Alex Karloutsos. Such information has been particularly helpful over the years in our efforts to protect the religious freedom of His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew.

Many Americans misunderstand the meaning of Thomas Jefferson's phrase "separation of church and state" as it relates to religious leaders. It does <u>not</u> mean that religious leaders cannot be involved with their government. It means that our country cannot have an official religion. This protects religious freedom for all. As you know, our Founders had witnessed many bad experiences in European countries with official state religions.

In the months ahead, if an issue with regard to our church arises in Washington, DC, like the religious freedom of our Ecumenical Patriarchate, we may reach out to you. In such cases, as we've done over many years, we'll prepare for your consideration a carefully worded letter to your US Senators and Member of Congress for you to send them. You can rest assured that such efforts are in coordination with the Archdiocese and entirely consistent with the appropriate conduct of America's religious leaders. If you send such a letter, we will make sure that it gets through the tens-of-thousands of communications Senators and Members receive each week and to their attention.




