

#### Pastoral Message from Fr. George for 7.28.23



In addition to reading this summer, I have been looking at ways to engage with family and friends when opportunities arise. This past Monday, Presbytera Marinda and I joined Faye Georgeo with two of our grandchildren to visit a peach farm in northeast Georgia. What was special about this? Faye invited us to join her... a simple and kind act that involved her giving some of her personal time up to share with others. We are not related by blood, but as brothers and sisters in Christ, I reflected on the Christian virtues of her gifts of time and presence to facilitate an unexpected fun family outing. During our road trip we sang, played games in the car, and shared coffee fellowship at her home before and after the field trip (as my grandson called it). At the peach farm, we ate together, shopped and exchanged ideas for canning fruits and vegetables, and taught our grandchildren the importance of farms and raising fresh food. 
Fr. Paul, Dean of the Annunciation Cathedral shared this tribute about Nicodemos when he received the Archangel Michael Honors Aware for 2013:



### Prison Awareness Sunday July 30, 2023

#### **Mission**

Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry serves those who are incarcerated and their families, and provides resources, training and support to our ministry partners so that lives are transformed and God is glorified.

#### What is OCPM?

For Orthodox Christians who have been arrested for crimes, OCPM helps them return to the Faith, offering forgiveness and reconciliation with Christ. For both Orthodox and non-Orthodox alike, OCPM provides spiritual care, enabling prisoners to find hope and purpose in their lives.

#### What does OCPM Do?

- They correspond with prisoners to provide personalized spiritual care, Bibles, books, icons, catechism, and study courses.
- Provide spiritual guidance to families of those incarcerated.
- They catechize prisoners in the Orthodox faith through a series of correspondence study courses.
- They train Orthodox priests and laypersons to visit and counsel those in prison and to provide the Sacraments.
- Provide ongoing guidance to those released from prison.
- OCPM advocates for correctional facilities around the country to recognize the Orthodox faith so that priests can enter prisons and administer the Sacraments and the services.




