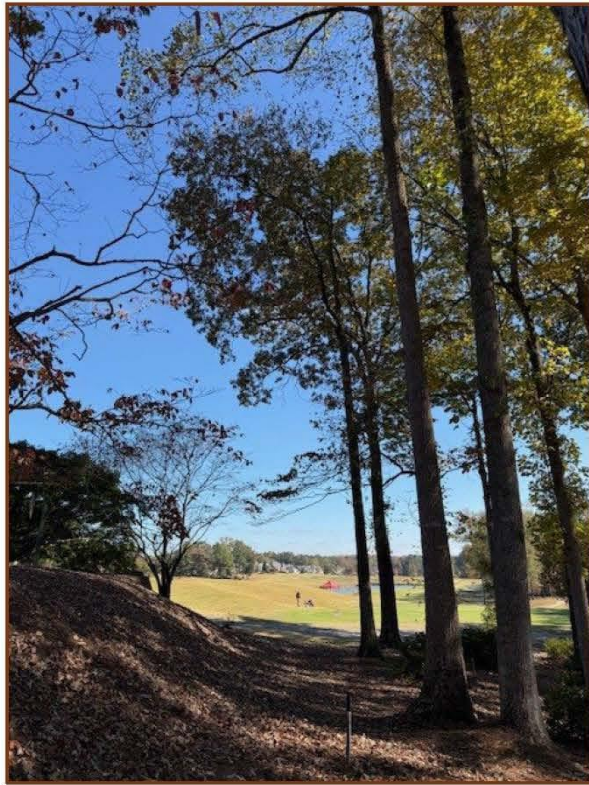

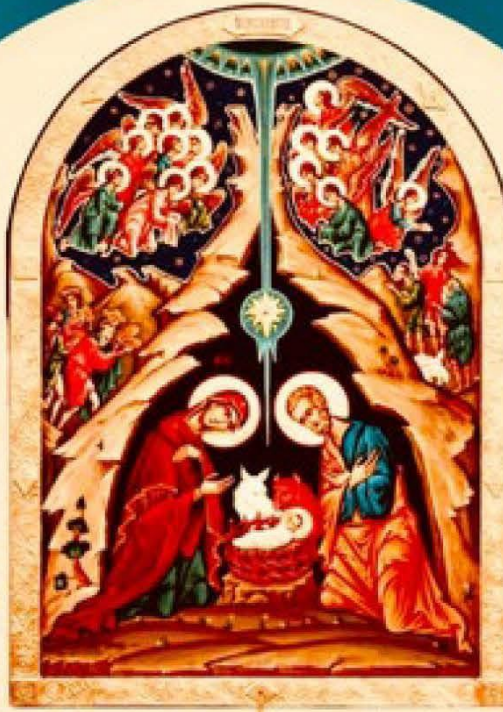

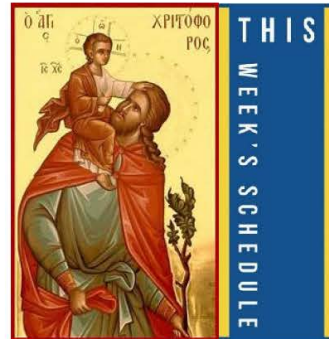

4 CYBERSECURITY ESSENTIALS



Update Your Software

Updating software and devices is the easiest way to stay protected from security threats. Perform updates as soon as they become available or set automatic updates.



Use Strong Passwords

Use a random string of mixed-case letters, numbers and symbols (at least 16 characters), like: Yuc8\$RikA34%ZoPt. Never reuse passwords. Use a password manager.



Enable Multifactor Authentication

MFA provides an extra layer of security for your accounts. Choose the most secure method available. A physical security key provides the best protection and is easy to use.



Recognize & Report Phishing Scams

Keep an eye out for scam attempts in your emails, texts, direct messages or phone calls. Always verify the sender before clicking links or downloading attachments. If you spot a scam, report it!

Stay smart online. Protect yourself and your loved ones with strong passwords and secure devices, and cautiously approach suspicious emails and links. Your digital safety is in your hands!

1. Keep software up to date. Enable auto-updates on all your devices.
2. Use strong passwords. Create unique passwords for all accounts and consider using a password manager like Apple's Password or 1Password. Phrases of at least 16 characters mixed with numbers or symbols are best.
3. Enable two-factor authentication on all accounts.
4. Be alert to phishing! Always verify a sender and think before you click.

CYBER SECURITY WATCH

CYBERCRIME HAS BEEN INFILTRATING OUR LIVES FOR YEARS.

More recently, parishes and religious communities around us are being targeted by a phishing scam where the attacker poses falsely as the parish priest and asks the recipient for money usually in the form of gift cards.

EDUCATE yourselves and others about the dangers of emails and phone scams.

YOUR PARISH PRIEST *should never* reach out via personal email to request immediate financial assistance. Be vigilant if you do receive an email that fits this description! Here are some do's and do not's to guide you:

DO NOT...

- ❌ reply to the message
- ❌ click on any links
- ❌ download any attachments
- ❌ use the contact information provided in the email
- ❌ share personal or financial data via email or phone

DO...FOLLOW THE 3 V'S

- ✅ **VIGILANCE** requires that you should question every email that comes in
- ✅ **VERIFY** the email by contacting your parish
- ✅ **VERY OFTEN** change your passwords

Do you or an exceptional undergraduate student you know qualify to be a PanHellenic Scholar? The 2025/2026 application is now open and accepting applications!

APPLY TODAY!

The Foundation will accept applications from eligible Greek American college students and will distribute \$250,000 in scholarship awards to exceptional undergraduates as follows:

- **Twenty (20) Awards of \$10,000** based on academic achievement, financial need, and Hellenic engagement. *(\$20,000 given specifically for students studying music or arts).*
- **Twenty (20) Awards of \$2,500** based on academic achievement and Hellenic engagement.

Eligible undergraduate students of Hellenic descent from all fifty states are encouraged to apply. If a student applied in a prior year, and are still in college, we encourage them to reapply.

Applications should be submitted electronically as instructed by **January 31, 2026**.

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, applicants must:

- Be US Citizens or US permanent residents.
- Be of Hellenic descent.
- Be enrolled at an accredited U.S. college or university for Fall 2025 and actively in your **sophomore, junior, or senior year**
- Have a minimum 3.6 cumulative GPA.

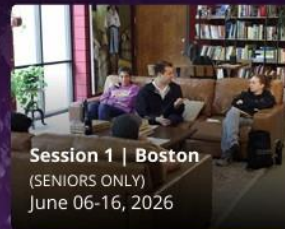
