

May 29th truly was special! On the Feast of Holy Ascension, the presence of Fr. Ted Sirotko, an 89-year-old retired Orthodox Priest worshiping with us at our Divine Liturgy was deeply meaningful for all who Father's were present. recollection of his journey into Orthodoxy after decades of service was


filled with wisdom, faith, and devotion. His beautiful testament to faith and divine calling recalled the voice of God leading him from the business world to serve as one of His ministers. His heartfelt insights reflected a deep spiritual understanding that we are led not just by circumstance, but by a higher purpose. Fr. Ted's journey to become an Orthodox Priest brought a sense of joy and encouragement especially to our youth present. For those who couldn't be there, I hope they can feel the same warmth and inspiration through these words, since our livestreaming video did not succeed in broadcasting his remarks to share with those viewing from home.

On this Feast of the Ascension of our Lord, it's inspiring to see how God calls people from different walks of life into His service, sometimes in ways they never expected. Hearing stories like Fr. Ted's reminds us that faith often requires courage and the willingness to start anew.

God reveals His grace through the deep humility and resilience of those who have faced difficult challenges and risen above them. I always feel it is incredibly moving to witness someone



seize opportunities and use their experiences to help others connect with the Lord. Indeed, God uses each of us to help transform humanity through our faith and obedience to His will.





Pentecost and Prayer Shawls

On the same Sunday we will be celebrating Pentecost, June 8th, Fr. George will also be blessing our next donation of Prayer Shawls. In the **Prayer of the Holy Spirit**, we pray: "Heavenly King, Comforter, the Spirit of Truth, everywhere present and filling all things, Treasury of blessings and Giver of life: come and abide in us, cleanse us from every impurity and save our souls, O Good One." This prayer is one that is, also, prayed numerous times as each shawl is being handcrafted.

Pentecost is also when, upon receiving the Holy Spirit, the disciples began to take God's



word to all nations. YOCAMA (Young Orthodox Christian American Mission Adventure) is trying to fulfill this mandate by organizing mission groups to help on the Blackfeet and Navajo Nations. St. Christopher's member, Isabelle Wiley, will be returning to serve on an YOCAMA team in June, and possible taking other members with her. She will also be delivering our Prayer Shawls. Earlier this year through the efforts of Angelique Soulakos, 12 prayer shawls were shared

with BeLoved Atlanta. This organization is a 2-year residential program assisting survivors of sex trafficking heal and become independent by the time they leave. These women received their shawls and our prayers (and a teddy bear) as part of a Valentine's Day party they were given. BELOVED believes every woman escaping sexual exploitation deserves a place of restoration within community. 


