



#### Eucharistic Miracles from around the World

Hasselt, Belgium in 1317 a priest brought the Holy Eucharist to a man who was ill. He left it in the Ciborium on a table while he spoke with the man and his family. In the meantime, a person in mortal sin approached



the Ciborium opened it and picked up the Eucharist which began to bleed. Frightened, the person put it back and left. The Eucharist was transported to a convent in Liege, Belgium where it was enshrined.

When it was brought to the Altar, all those in attendance saw a vision of Jesus with thorns on his head. During the French Revolution, the Eucharist had to be hidden but was eventually enshrined at St. Quentin Church where it remains in splendid condition.
