Just as the altar is a sign of Christ the living stone, Altar Cloths are used "out of reverence for the celebration of the memorial of the Lord and for the banquet in which the Body and Blood of the Lord are offered" Corporals, Purificators, Palls, Lavabo Towels, (the term "lavabo" comes from the Latin root 'lava' meaning to wash), also serve a practical purpose, absorbing whatever may be spilled of the Precious Blood or other sacramental elements. How we treat sacred things fosters and expresses our openness to the graces God gives to His Church in every celebration of the Eucharist. Thus, by the diligent care of the altar linens, the Church expresses her joy at the inestimable gifts she receives from Christ's altar. Those who care for sacred cloths of the liturgy appropriately accompany their work with prayer.
