Special Grace promised by Jesus The greatness of this feast of Divine Mercy is measured by the measure of extraordinary promises that the Lord attached to this feast: Jesus said "Whoever approached the Fount of Life on this day will be granted **complete remission of sins and punishment**" (Diary, 300), and also "On this day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My Mercy. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet" (Diary, 699). Jesus requested that a feast day be dedicated to His Divine Mercy on the Sunday after Easter. This vision was officially realized in the year 2000 when St. Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and added the feast to the Church's universal calendar.
