Presenter: Sister Christine Kouba, Cathy Lentz

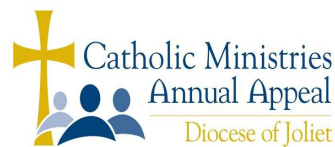

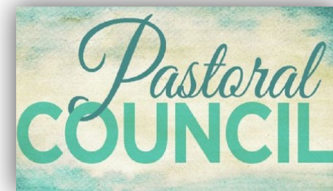
