Come to Me, All You Who are Burdened (Mt 11:28)

The Church was founded by Christ. He established it upon St. Peter and the Apostles. For what purpose? In a word, salvation! Eternal salvation. Universal salvation, that is, no one who seeks him in sincere faith leading to repentance, is excluded from his grace and mercy. In the Gospel according to St. John, we learn of the conversation Jesus had with Nicodemus. Jesus told him: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the son of man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life" (JN 3:14-15). Jesus clearly desires that everyone come to believe in him. It is necessary for eternal life. He will soon be lifted up, on the Cross, that is. Jesus' obedience to the Father's will brings about the reality that belief in Jesus as Savior, Son of God and Lord of all leads to eternal life. We hear again from the Gospel according to St. John: Now, at the Passover Feast some Greeks made their request of the Apostle Philip: "Sir, we would like to see Jesus" (JN 12:20-21). Meanwhile, the tension is clearly building among the Pharisees and others even more strident in their opposition to Jesus. They have begun to openly express to one another their desire to be rid of him. Jesus' response to Andrew and Philip that some Greeks would like to see him indicates the nearness of that hour for which he had come: "I am troubled now. Yet what should I say? 'Father, save me from this hour?' But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name" (JN 12:27-28). Jesus then repeats to the crowd gathered what he had said earlier to Nicodemus: "And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself" (JN 12:32).

Throughout our Lord's public ministry many approached him from outside of the Chosen People. Some are quite surprised, still others perturbed, that Jesus should pay attention to such people, let alone show such compassion toward them. We think of the woman at the well, a Samaritan. There was the Roman military official seeking healing on behalf of his loved one. True, some people were merely curious, wanting only to see a miraculous performance, like the citizens of Nazareth who had so little faith. Others had a deep faith. Now, as Jesus faces the painful walk to Golgatha and his crucifixion there, the moment is coming when the whole world can and will be drawn to Jesus. At the foot of the cross we can make our requests known to him. We can let ourselves be drawn to him once again. Jesus said: "Now is the time of judgment on this world: now the ruler of this world will be driven out" (JN 12:31). Satan has been driven out! He knows it, but he refuses to act like it, given that he is as yet allowed by God to "roam about the world like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour" (II Peter 5:8). In the next verse St. Peter exhorts us to "resist the devil, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experience of suffering is required of your brothers and sisters throughout the world."

So, what now? Well, don't forget to come to our Parish Penance and Reconciliation Service this Wednesday evening April 6th at 7:00 p.m. Be drawn to the grace and mercy of Jesus.

Please Support The Invest in Kids Scholarship Tax Credit Program



What is the Invest in Kids Scholarship Tax Credit Program?

This legislation allows individuals and corporations to donate to scholarship-granting organizations (SGO) and receive a credit on their state taxes in return. This may be a significant benefit to benefactors because it is a tax credit rather than a deduction which is typical for charitable contributions. The SGO will use the donations to grant scholarships to qualifying students.

What does this mean for St. Joseph School?

Benefactors can designate their contributions to St. Joseph School. Benefactors may make a charitable contribution of any amount up to \$1 million for scholarship programs and receive a state tax credit of 75%. The SGO will provide scholarship dollars for families that meet the income requirements.

How much is the tax credit worth?

An individual or corporate donor will receive a 75% state tax credit on their donation. *As an example: a donor donates \$10,000, they will receive a state tax credit of \$7,500.*

How does that donation process work?

Individual donors interested in applying will be able to reserve these tax credits on the Illinois Department of Revenue website. www.mytax.illinois.gov.

Dear Friends,

With the onset of the coronavirus pandemic more than two years ago, our goal in the Diocese of Joliet has been to ensure the safety and well-being of all clergy, religious, lay ministers, parishioners, employees and volunteers while providing access to worship and the Eucharist. We have adjusted our safety protocols as COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations increased and then decreased. I want to personally thank you for your diligence in safeguarding the health of our brothers and sisters in Christ.

When the state of Illinois lifted its mask mandate for indoor public places on February 28, we followed suit for all church and office activities. We also removed practically all other precautions, but left in place the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass.

The time has come to remove that final provision, and we will do so on Palm Sunday. What better time for us all to come together again than Palm Sunday, which marks the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and the beginning of Holy Week.

Of course, if individuals are ill or contagious to others, Canon law allows them to decide for themselves if they should attend Mass.

I am excited the Diocese of Joliet will fully reunite as one body in Christ for the liturgies leading up to Easter and beyond.

I am reminded of the words Pope Francis wrote in *Fratelli Tutti* during the initial months of the pandemic: "Let us dream, then, as a single human family, as fellow travelers sharing the same flesh, as children of the same earth which is our common home, each of us bringing the richness of his or her beliefs and convictions, each of us with his or her own voice, brothers and sisters all."
(Paragraph 8)

Let us welcome home our family with joy and continue to pray for each other.
