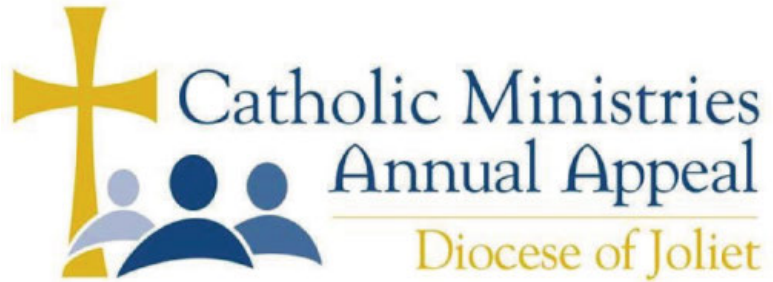

Your Gift to the CMAA Makes a Difference

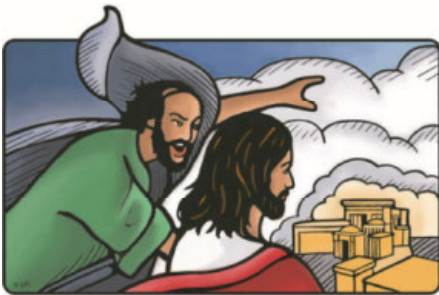
