

### A Time to Rejoice, to Remember, and to Give Thanks

*In all circumstances, give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus!* (1 Thessalonians 5:18).

Our celebration of the Eucharist grounds us in the spirit of thanksgiving. We come to the Lord's Table rejoicing in the love offered with Christ's Body and Blood. We remember those who have died who are always a part of us and with those who see God face to face—the Communion of Saints. We give thanks for all gifts given to us so generously. Though not a liturgical season, November liturgies, filled with scripture, prayers, and songs that reflect the end of time, call each of us to prepare for that final day when the Lord gathers us to himself just as the harvest is gathered from the land. The days of Ordinary Time culminate with the celebration of the *Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe* on Sunday, November 26 and flow into the coming Advent season. And as a nation, we gather for our own national holiday – Thanksgiving – to give thanks to God, the giver of all gifts.

### Thursday, November 23 (9:00 a.m.)

Celebrate Thanksgiving Day with your parish at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. We gather to offer thanks and praise as many households, but one family in Christ. Members of the assembly will carry non-perishable food items in procession at the Preparation of the Gifts. Gift certificates can be used to purchase perishable items. This ritual of solidarity with those in need helps the St. Vincent de Paul Society continue its mission of service to those who hunger, and to offer support for their households.




