Fast for Creation Care

2023 was the hottest year on record. Pope Francis continues to remind us that irresponsible consumption patterns and their associated carbon pollution have a very real and negative impact on the poor. The prophet Isaiah suggested that the only kind of fasting worth our time is fasting that "breaks unjust bonds, ... and does not turn its back on its own" (Is. 58:6-7). Consider taking decisive steps this Lenten season to hear "the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor," and to reduce energy consumption.

Simple individual steps you can take include eating less meat, eating lower on the food chain, driving and flying less, adjusting the thermostat, wasting less water, generating less plastic waste and stepping-up your personal advocacy. This message is even more urgent now because of our planet's ecological crisis, which has as its root causes overconsumption and misuse of the earth's resources.

However, amid this intense suffering, God began to touch her soul. Josephine began to yearn to know the Creator. Josephine was purchased by an Italian family and taken to Italy. She eventually converted to Catholicism and became a religious sister. Josephine was known for her love and gentleness and deep holiness. At her death in 1947, miracles began to abound.




