

## \*Sign –ups for Mass <u>No Longer Required</u> by the State.

However, parishes are still required to limit Mass attendance to capacity limits according to Risk Level per each county in Oregon. Pastors and parishes are simply required to ensure maximum numbers allowed are not exceeded at any given faith gathering. For many of our parishes, this change will still mean some kind of reservation system for Masses. Door monitors/hospitality ministers will still be needed to ensure masking, distancing and cleaning protocols are followed and maximum number are not exceeded. \*St. Boniface Church has increased to 80 people maximum(70 downstairs/10 in choir loft plus choir members) and 25 in Parish hall.


