"Sent To Announce Peace"

When you read St. Paul's letter to the Romans..(Rom 10:14-17), is saying that one cannot believe in Christ without first having heard somebody announcing him. Yes, that's how the seed of faith was planted to each one of us by hearing the word of God preached by either one of our relatives or ministers of the church or by our relatives or even by our friends. So our gospel reading today begins by recalling the need to have many people who will announce the word of God; it then goes on showing how these people are to carry out the mission they have been called to; they are finally invited not to get discouraged because evil has already been defeated and the victory of the kingdom of God is sure.

The first reading is well in line with this last part of the gospel; when in difficulty one should not forget that the promises of God will always be realized. The lamb does not rely on his strength but on the help of the shepherd; the child may be weak, but feels quite safe in the arms of his mother. Also, the second reading is about this. Paul says that his force and glory is the cross of Christ. Anybody proclaiming the gospel cannot rely on human power: his only strength is the one coming from the Word that he proclaims. And so, the word preached leads to the victory after a long march and difficulty way which is encroached by the evils such as bad habit, violence and vices. But in spite of this, Jesus, looking at the final outcome, sees that evil has already lost all its power. And so, the victory of good over evil cannot be stopped by all means, and on this way the peace over hatred will prevail.

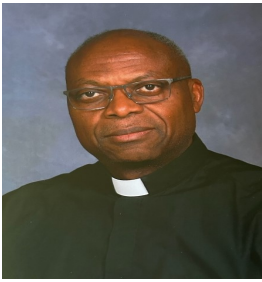

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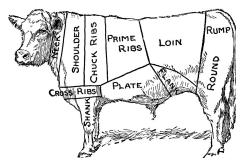
